

NCBC Articulation Agreement - BSSM

Northern California Bible College has assessed the transferability of Bethel School of Supernatural Ministry's (BSSM) core curriculum.

Summary of Curricular Requirements at BSSM

- Syllabi submitted show assignments for reading and discussion. There was no evidence of any other assignments or assessments.
- Grades are pass/fail
- Simpson University awards 9 semester units for BSSM year 1. This is 3-semester units in Bible and 6-semester units of general education. And Family of Faith is awarding 6 semester units of Christian Character Development and Understanding and Applying the Bible.
- Students are onsite, Tuesday through Friday, for four and one half hours (12-13 week fall term, 16-17 weeks Spring term).
- Topics include the following
 - Intro to Bible Exegesis, Interpretation and Application
 - Foundational Theology and Church History
 - Kingdom Theology and Identity
 - The Supernatural Nature of the Gospel
 - Spiritual and Community Formation
 - Prophetic Ministry in the Life of the Church
 - Outreach/Evangelism Practicum
 - Leadership Development

With this information, we have determined that students who have completed one year of BSSM can receive the following:

- Practical Ministry Electives (9 quarter units)

Students may be eligible for course credit for the following courses provided they work with an NCBC instructor and show proof of written reflection on the following topics and readings.

- Power Evangelism (3 quarter units)
- Healing Ministry (3 quarter units)
- Prophetic Ministry (3 quarter units)

BSSM ONLINE: There is no verification or evidence of participation or reflection. At this time NCBC cannot assess credits for the online program. This is an amazing program and opportunity for the online community but does not necessarily meet the student-professor interaction requirements.
